THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 5[™]

1:00-3:00PM "Stained glass" on plexiglass.

\$12 plus tax.

Class limit:12



This class will include several demonstrations of using different materials (hot glue, paint, inks, glass paint, etc.) to create a stained-glass effect on plexiglass. We will explore these different materials and try them out before creating our own piece of artwork.

6:00-8:00pm Pottery Wheel Throwing.

\$25 plus tax.

Class limit: 6



This fun two-hour session introduces beginners to basic wheel throwing techniques. You will have the opportunity to create a piece of functional art (cup, bowl, vase, etc.) on the pottery wheel. Your finished piece, once dry, will be fired in the kiln. Choose a glaze color before leaving class and your piece will be glazed, fired, and ready for pickup within 3 weeks. No experience necessary. All supplies and equipment provided.

TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 10TH

1:00-3:00PM- Hand-building a ceramic lidded dish.

Class limit: 12



This class will learn different techniques to use when hand-building with clay. We will find different objects and ways to add texture to their project and learn how to secure pieces of clay together. Students will design a lidded bowl or dish and use the skills learned during this class to build their own lidded bowl/dish.

6:00-8:00PM Painting Birch trees with Acrylic Paint

Class limit: 12



With Birch trees as the subject, this class will learn techniques and clever tricks to painting a beautiful landscape painting of any season. The class will be shown different tools that may be used when painting with acrylic paint. Artists will work on a 16x20 canvas.

Georgia O'Keeffe was an American artist renowned for her enlarged flower paintings. This class will choose a favorite flower from provided photo references of flowers and create a piece of art influenced by O'Keeffe's style. Artists in this class may choose chalk pastels, watercolor paints, or acrylic paints to create their artwork.

Memory Wire beaded bracelets and earring set.

Using memory wire we will create a beaded bracelet and a pair of earring to match. choose from dozens of beads to create a beautiful jewelry set for yourself or as a gift. All supplies included.

In the class, we'll be making flowers in different sizes and colors. We will learn how to create several different kinds of flowers using crepe paper and tissue paper. Artists can then focus on making one type of flower, or several different kinds of flowers and will end this session with a beautiful bouquet of hand-made tissue paper flowers.

6:00-8:00PM MACRAME WALL HANGING

In this two-hour workshop you will: Learn how to begin a macrame piece, including an overview of necessary materials. How to work a few different macrame knots and how to create design, texture, and pattern.

TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 24TH



6:00-8:00PM HAND-BUILDING CERAMIC BIRD FEEDERS/HOUSES.

Class Limit: 10

Slab building is a common technique used to make ceramic objects. This involves rolling out clay, cutting it into shapes, and then putting the pieces together. This class will learn the slab building technique then have the opportunity to design and create their own ceramic bird feeder/house. Artists will have the option to stop back to the art house to either paint their bird feeder/house with acrylic paint or ceramic glaze once it has been fired.
